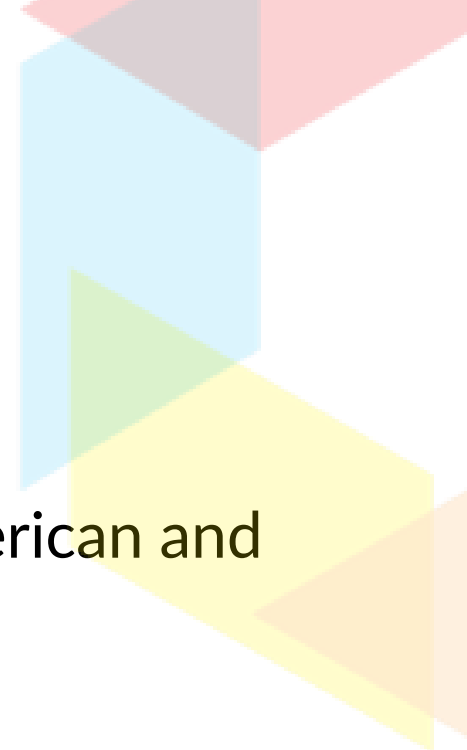
The community of financial institutions that create development banking solutions to further Latin American and Caribbean progress.

Training and Capacity Building

Services of specialized advisory and internships in the various fields of banking and finance for development

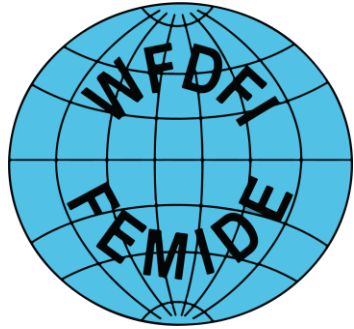

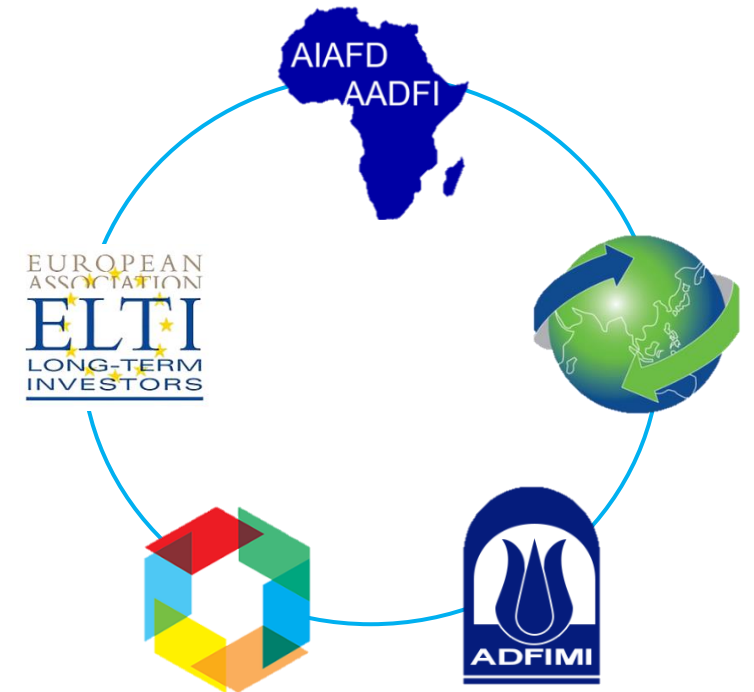
ALIDE: Bridge between Regions

PARTICIPATION

MORE THAN CONFERENCES

Analysis and discussions of current trends in development financing, particularly economic and financial policies that are an important reference point for the evolution and performance of development finance institutions.

STRATEGIC NETWORKING

A meeting point for establishing and strengthening personal relationships and ties with senior banking authorities in Latin America and other regions, which can then be capitalized on to identify opportunities for joint action.

SPECIALIZED TECHNICAL MEETINGS

Parallel meetings/side events or workshops that allow innovative topics or programs that institutions wish to share and present to the financial community to be addressed.
